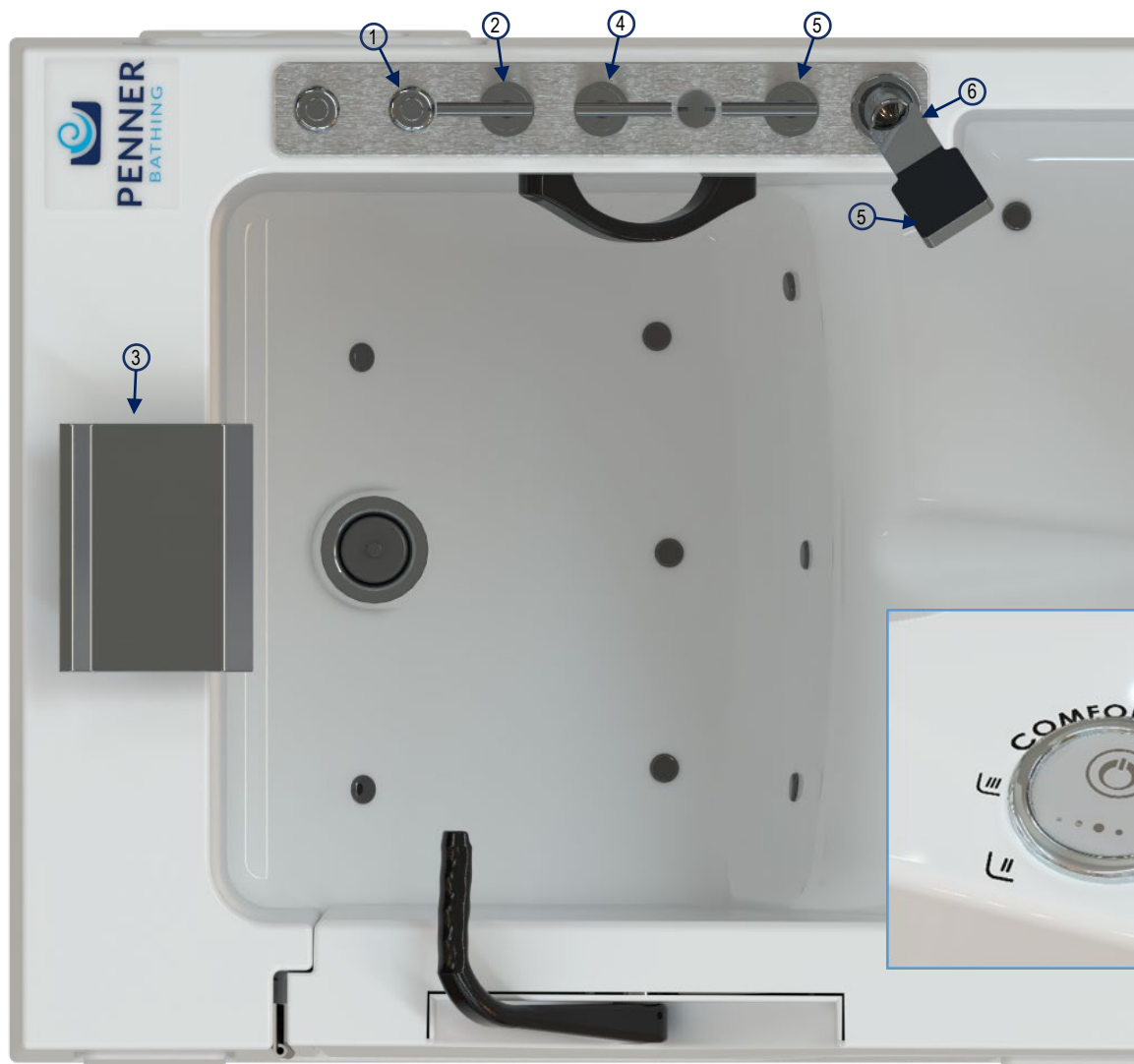

Internal Spa View

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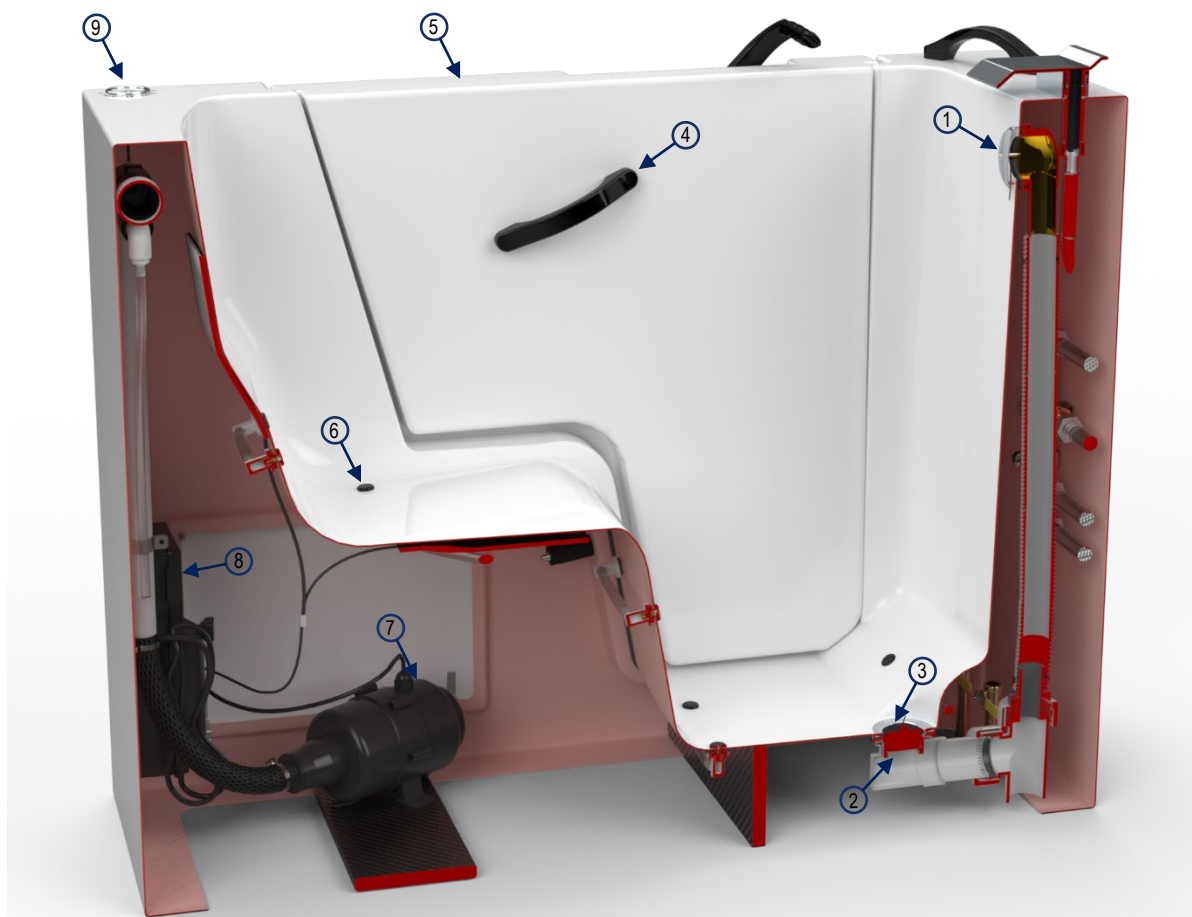
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Components of spa are referenced in relation to the front of the spa. The front of the spa is as a person sits in the spa facing the controls as shown below.

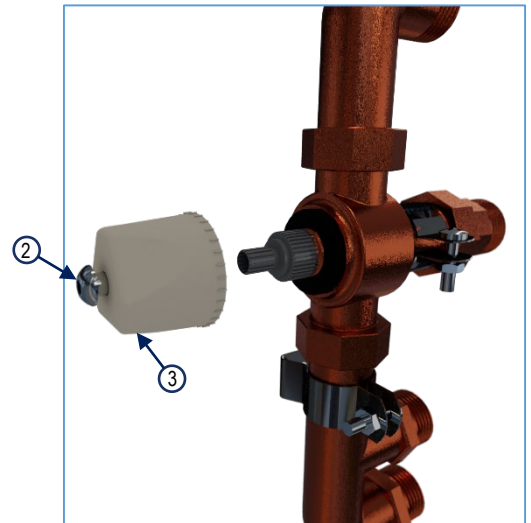
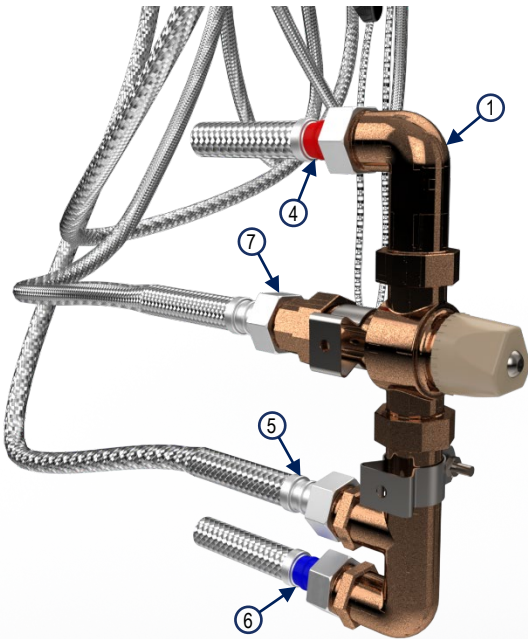
Max "Hot" Temperature Adjustment

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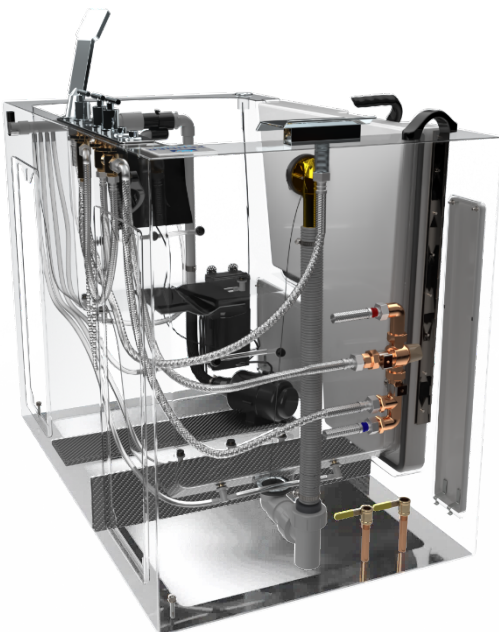

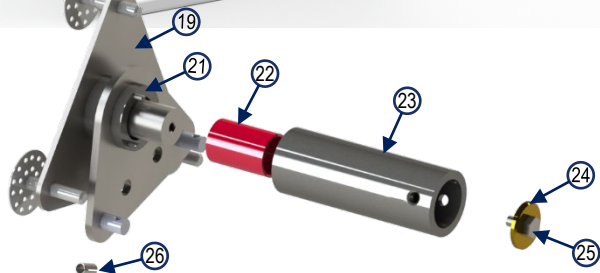
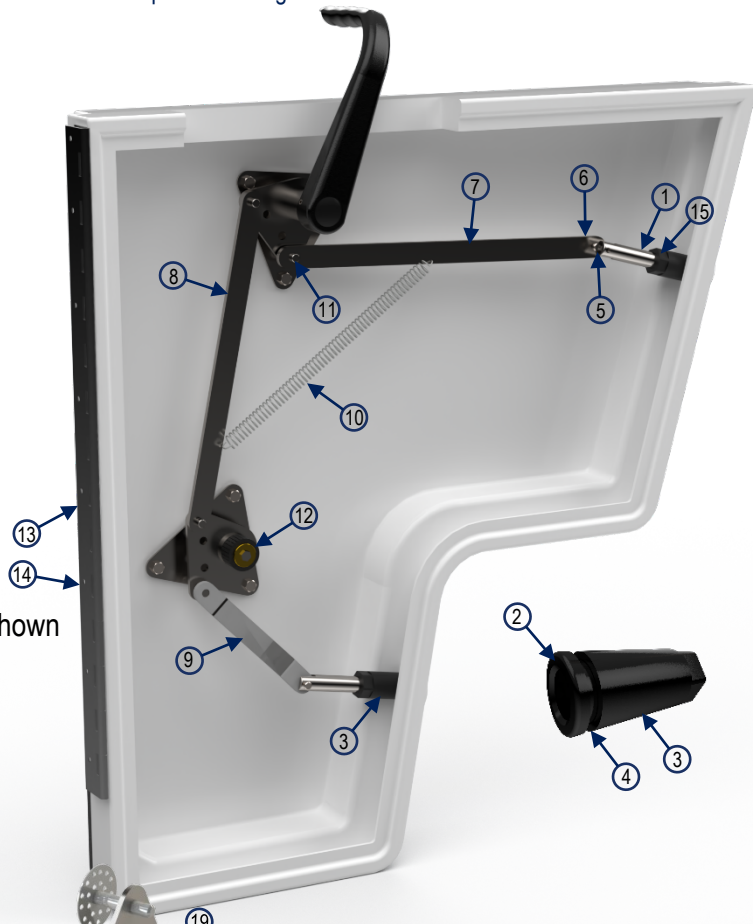
Tempering Valve Adjustment Procedure

To adjust the max hot temperature, use the provided Allen wrench to remove screw from cap of tempering valve. Take cap part way off valve so only inner splines of cap make contact with brass splines of valve. Rotate cap clockwise to decrease hot water temperature. Rotate cap counterclockwise to increase hot water temperature. This is done looking at the face of the cap as mounted on the tempering valve. Valve is set to 110F° at the factory for maximum hot temperature.

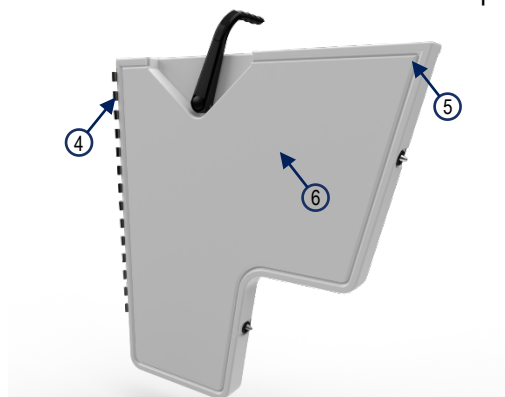
Note: A little turn can make a big temperature adjust. Make sure to test temp to avoid scalding. Using a known good temperature gauge and to verify let water run on wrist.

The door assembly can be easily removed from the spa by using a #2 Phillips screwdriver and removing the screws on the spa side hinge leaf.

Front access doors (7&8) can be removed simply by pulling the top portion away from the spa and lifting. Magnets are up top to hold the covers on with clips at the bottom to clamp in place. Rear access doors (9) will use a key that needs to be used to turn the lock. Then pull the top portion away and lift rear access door up to completely remove.

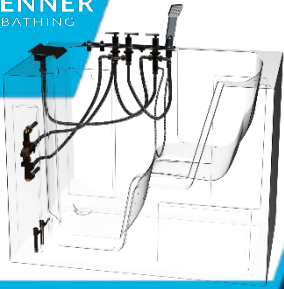
Air Jets can be cleaned from hard build up by using a 21/64 drill bit and a 1/4 drill bit. Run the bits through the jet body after removing the cap and internal check valve components. The 21/64 bit will bottom out on a shoulder in the jet body. The 1/4 bit will run all the way through to the tee fitting. **DO NOT USE POWER TOOLS.** Run drill bits by hand.

A removal tool may be ordered to tighten or loosen Base Shoe Basket from Base Shoe Assembly. DO NOT overtighten as this may cause the Base Shoe Assembly to crack and create leaks.

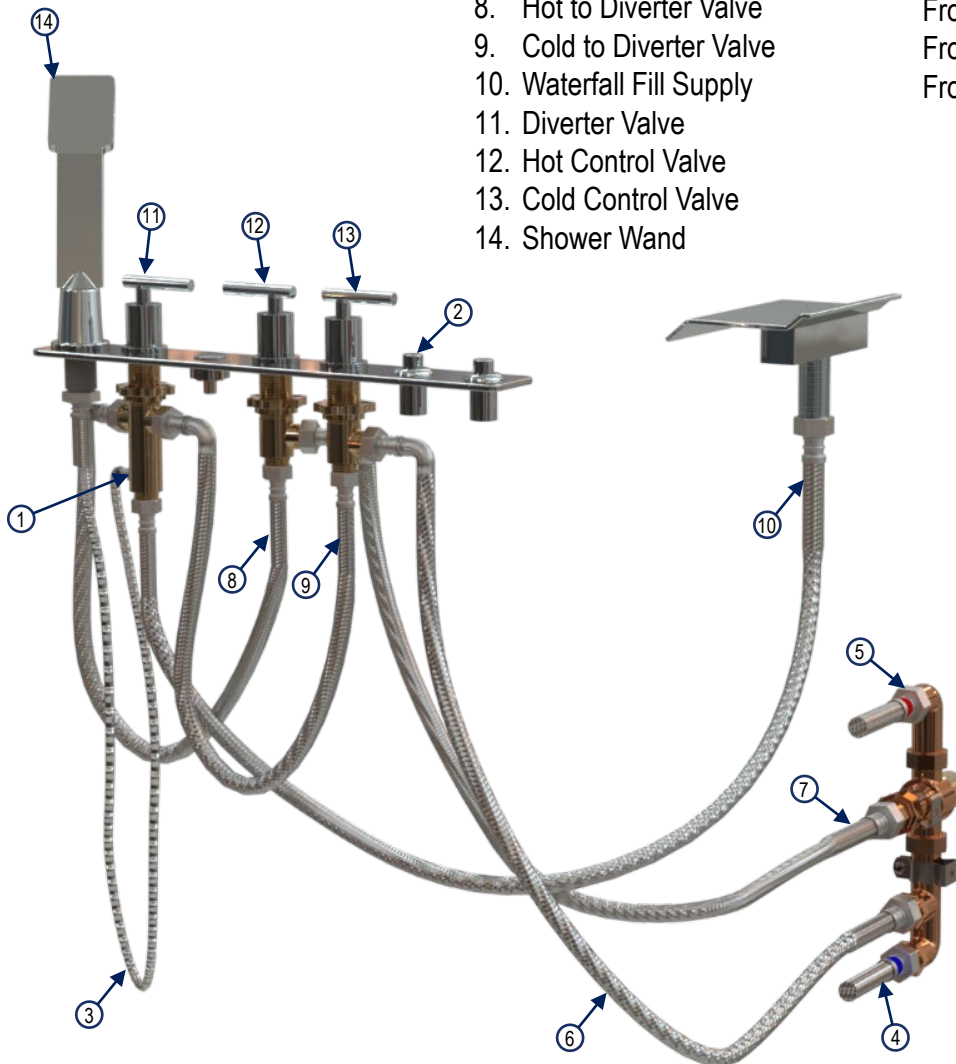

Load Center-Comfort Warm System

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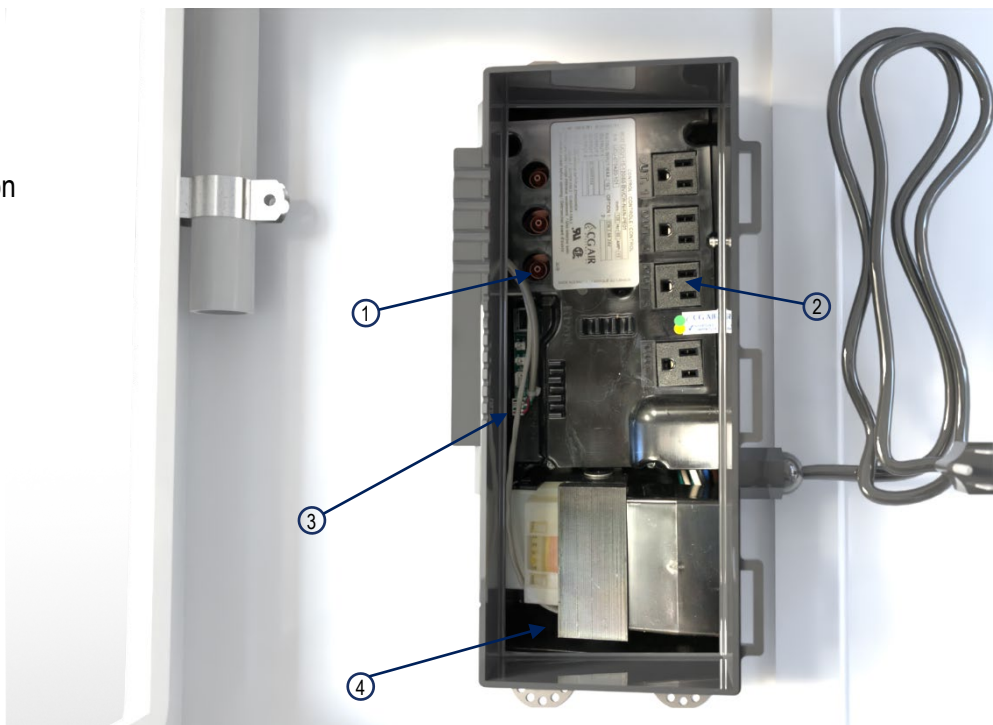
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Load Center 760500

The Load Center is a no repair item. If it has been determined that the load center is at fault, replacement of the unit will be necessary. Open the lid, disconnect the air line, blower motor supply, Comfort Warm power supply and then use a 3/8" nut driver to take off the nuts (350955) to remove the unit.

1. Air Switch air line connection
2. Air Blower Motor Connection #3
3. Comfort Warm Keypad Connection
4. Comfort Warm power supply



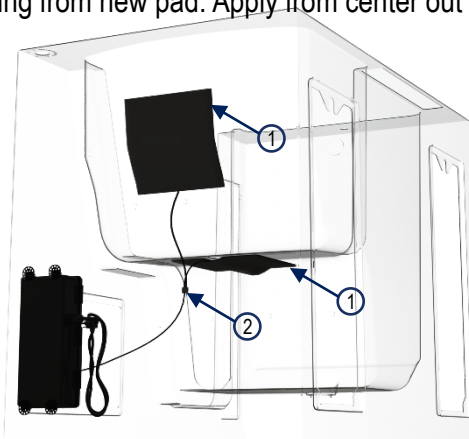
Comfort Warm System

The Comfort Warm keypad controls three levels of heat. Pushing the button repeatedly will cycle through the different levels of heat with the first push being the hottest and the fourth turning the Comfort Warm off. They will also automatically shut off after 30min.

Heating pads are stuck on with a high strength adhesive. If replacing, disconnect wire connections and peel off pad. Clean with an alcohol wipe or non-residue cleaner and peel backing from new pad. Apply from center out of pad and press firmly. Reconnect wires. Do not remove white insulation backing.
